

FOODS FED AT THE CAT CAFE

Dry food: Purina Cat Chow Naturals—we use both the Original and Indoor formulas. This is the most reasonably priced food we have found with a protein as its first ingredient and which does not have Red 40 dye. **PLEASE DO NOT FEED YOUR CAT DRY FOOD OR TREATS WITH RED DYE.** If the food looks red or orange, it likely has Red 40 dye in it, and it is not good for their tummies or general health.

Wet food: We feed a few different kinds of wet food in various forms, such as Pate (best for mixing in supplements), shreds, cuts, etc. The twin (snap) packets work well for single cat households and are made by various manufacturers with lots of flavor and texture options, so you can find one your cat likes. We **HIGHLY** recommend incorporating wet food into your cat's diet at least once per day as it helps them to stay hydrated, which helps prevent future health issues such as kidney and thyroid disease. If your cat is one of the few that doesn't like wet food, consider getting a water fountain to help them drink more water.
